Western Pyrotechnic Association
Membership Policies and Fees
Adopted 9-16-14

The WPA has the following membership levels:

- Regular Member: Age 18 years or older, not a full-time student
- Student Member: Full-time student (high school, or currently enrolled in 12 units of college credit), age 18-25
- Gold Member: Same as regular member, but provides a way of showing additional support for the club; often affiliated with a company, but not necessarily. (Similar to previous Corporate Member.)
- Lifetime Member: Same as regular member, but never expires. Limited to current WPA members age 55 and older, who have been an active WPA member for at least 10 years.

Before being accepted as a new member, an applicant must meet one of the following qualifications:

- Be a licensed pyrotechnic operator
- Be a member in good standing of another pyrotechnic organization
- Provide references of two current WPA members in good standing
- Provide a written letter explaining applicant's interest in pyrotechnics, and why applicant should be considered for membership

Membership expiration is determined as follows:

- New members expire one year after joining.
- When renewing, non-expired members, will have their expiration date extended by one year.
- When renewing, expired members will expire one year after the renewal date.
- Lifetime memberships never expire.

As a member's expiration date approaches, they will receive a reminder of the upcoming expiration. This reminder will also be sent to their area vice president.

Current annual membership fees are as follows:

- New or renewing Regular Member: \$80
- Regular membership for spouse or life partner (new and renewing): \$50
- Student Member (new and renewing): \$50
- Gold Member (new and renewing): \$250
- Lifetime membership (15 times regular member renewal): \$1,200

The Board of Directors has the authority to revoke and reinstate membership privileges for any member, per the WPA Bylaws.
