**Western Winter Blast 2017 Registration Policies and Fees**  
 Adopted 10-26-2016

1. To participate in Western Winter Blast 28 (AKA Western Winter Blast 2017), a person must be an active member of the WPA, or be the spouse, child, or sponsored guest of an active attending member.
2. WWB 2017 has the following registration categories and fees:

3. Spouse, partner, or children of Event Staff pay the fee shown above.
4. Children 5 and under may attend with their parents for free.
5. Any current member that is registered for the event may have his or her spouse, whether the spouse is a member or not, attend the event at the reduced spouse rate.
6. A \$15.00 clean up fee is included in the registration fee as noted in the above fee table. Any person registered for the event, in any of the above categories, who ACTIVELY PARTICIPATES and stays until cleanup is complete on Monday, will receive a share of the clean-up fee as a refund. The amount will be calculated after clean-up expenses are determined. Children (less than 18) are ineligible to participate in clean-up for safety reasons.
7. A vendor must be an active member and registered for WWB. A limited number of vendor helpers will be admitted free, with limited site privileges. See Vendor registration form for details on registering vendor helpers.
8. Participant sponsorships for the event are available at multiple donation levels. Each level includes a specific number of event registrations for individuals. (see Participant Sponsorship form for details)
9. A person who has never been a WPA member can attend a WPA event without a membership as a "Sponsored Guest", with the following conditions:
  - a. A person can do this ONCE in their lifetime.
  - b. They must be sponsored by an active member who is attending the event.
  - c. A member can only sponsor one Sponsored Guest per event.
  - d. They cannot preorder any product or buy "Class B" product.
  - e. They have no member number.
  - f. They cannot bring their spouse or other family members.
  - g. They may attend the annual meeting, but they cannot vote.
10. Any fraudulent use of event credentials, such as use of previous year's or someone else's, will result in disciplinary action against all involved persons, at the discretion of the WPA Board of Directors.
11. RV parking is available in a designated area for current WPA members, who must be registered for the event. The rate is \$40 for the entire event, regardless of arrival date, with a limit of one RV space per member.
