Western Winter Blast 2022 Registration Policies and Fees

Adopted 10/24/21

1. To participate in Western Winter Blast 33 (AKA Western Winter Blast 2022), a person must be an active member of the WPA, or be the spouse, child, or sponsored guest of an active attending member.
2. WWB 2022 has registration categories and fees as detailed on page 1 of this registration form.
3. A \$20.00 clean up deposit is included in the registration fee as noted in the fee table. Any person registered for the event in any category except child, who ACTIVELY PARTICIPATES in cleanup, will receive a share of the clean-up fee as a refund, based on hours worked. You must sign in upon arrival and sign out when done cleaning. The amount will be calculated after clean-up expenses are determined. Children (less than 18) are ineligible to participate in clean-up for safety reasons.
4. Spouse, partner, or children of Event Staff pay the fee shown on the fee table.
5. Children 5 and under may attend with their parents for free.
6. Children and student members age 6-25 may participate in Pyros in Training (PIT) for no additional fee. Age 6-12 must be accompanied by an adult participant.
7. Any current member that is registered for the event may have his or her spouse, whether the spouse is a member or not, attend the event at the reduced spouse rate.
8. A vendor must be an active member and registered for WWB. A limited number of vendor helpers will be admitted free, with limited site privileges. See Vendor registration form for details on registering vendor helpers.
9. Participant sponsorships for the event are available at multiple donation levels. Each level includes a specific number of event registrations for individuals. (See Participant Sponsorship form for details)
10. A person who has never been a WPA member can attend a WPA event without a membership as a "Sponsored Guest", with the following conditions:
 - a. A person can do this ONCE in their lifetime.
 - b. They must be sponsored by an active member who is attending the event.
 - c. A member can only sponsor one Sponsored Guest per event.
 - d. They cannot preorder any product or buy "Class B" product.
 - e. They have no member number.
 - f. They cannot bring their spouse or other family members.
 - g. They may attend the annual meeting, but they cannot vote.
11. Any fraudulent use of event credentials, such as use of previous year's or someone else's, will result in disciplinary action against all involved persons, at the discretion of the WPA Board of Directors.
12. RV parking is available in a designated area for current WPA members and sponsored guests, who must be registered for the event. The rate is \$60 for the entire event, regardless of arrival date, with a limit of one RV space per member or sponsored guest. All persons entering the RV area must be registered for the event.
